Scholarship Overview: The Rev. Clifford E. Jones College Scholarship is dedicated to recognizing and supporting outstanding students who demonstrate exceptional commitment to volunteer service and strong leadership in their communities. The scholarship aims to reward students who make a meaningful impact through initiative, compassion, and civic engagement. Students planning to attend a technical college, a two-year college, or a four-year institution may apply. Applicants must have attended and will be graduating from a high school in Auburn, Opelika, or Lee County, Alabama, during the application cycle.

Criteria:

Applicants must be high school seniors, have a 2.5 GPA or higher, demonstrate significant volunteer experience and leadership roles, and submit a completed application that includes all supporting documentation by the deadline. Deadline date: April 15th

Submission Instructions
